# CALLING NEW PASTOR TIMELINE

Hello everyone! I hope you are staying warm and healthy during this winter season! I just wanted to give a brief update. Ona Martin is doing a remarkable job with the Ministry Site Profile (MSP)! The entire congregation received a survey by mail to complete and return. The results were tabulated and three lively MSP committee meetings have taken place to discuss the results and to begin for-

mulating our MSP. Due to COVID, we had to cancel our Jan 29 congregational MSP workshop, but within a few weeks, the congregation will be offered a draft copy to examine and provide comments. After any changes and council approval, the MSP will be filed with the synod to begin matching us with pastoral candidates. On another front, Council has agreed upon members to invite to be

on the Call Committee, and I am currently inviting these individuals. If you remember from the Congregational meeting in November, I presented a slide with a timeline and we are currently on track with that. Our initial plan was to get the MSP sent to the synod by early April and have the call committee in place by then. I will provide you with another update in March!

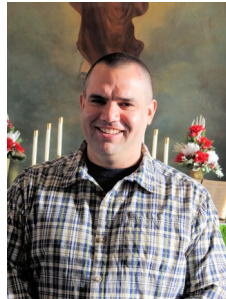

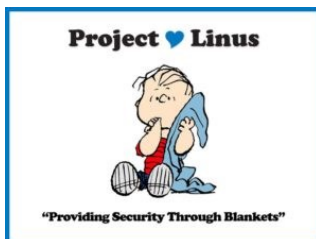
